For better transparency and proving user-friendly environment to the applicants, there shall not be any physical touch points between the applicant (Business/Citizens) and Department. Services are mandated through Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Guarantee Act, 2011 vide SRO-467,dated 16<sup>th</sup> October,2018 for timely approval and MIS dashboard is made available in the Single Window System.

Department of Geology & Mining has provided recommended services as per the guidelines of DPIIT, Gol for the following services: -

### Functionality description of 'NoC for soil excavation /filling'-

(Service would be covered under short term permit)

- STP (Short Term Permit) for RBM/Sand/Bajri would require:
  - NOC from DC concerned for title verification of land under revenue
  - Site Plan/ Map of area with Geo-coordinates duly authenticated by the concerned Revenue Authorities
  - Application form duly filled by applicant along with required fees of Rs 2000/-
  - Physical verification report of the applied area with recommendation of DMO concerned/ Regional Head
  - Environmental clearance from JKEIAA
  - Consent to operate from Pollution Control Board
- 2. STP (Short Term Permit) for clay/earth would require:
  - NOC from DC concerned for title verification of land under revenue
  - Site plans / Maps of area with Geo- coordinates duly authenticated by the concerned Revenue Authorities
  - Application form duly filled by applicant along with required fees of Rs 2000/-
  - Physical verification report of the applied area with recommendation of DMO concerned/ Regional Head
- Disposal Permit for excavated material during the process of construction of tunnels, canals, roads, bridges, buildings etc., would require:
  - Application form duly filled by applicant along with required fees of Rs 2000/-
  - NOC from DC concerned for title verification of land under revenue
  - Site Plan / Map of area with Geo- coordinates duly authenticated by the concerned Revenue Authorities
  - Physical verification report of the applied area with recommendation of DMO concerned/ Regional Head
- Disposal Permit for earth/clay/soil would require: -
  - Application form duly filled by applicant along with required fees of Rs 2000/-
  - NOC from DC concerned for title verification of land under revenue
  - Site Plan / Map of area with Geo- coordinates



- Site Plan / Map of area with Geo- coordinates duly authenticated by the concerned Revenue **Authorities**
- Physical verification report of the applied area with recommendation of DMO concerned/ Regional Head.
