Under Ease of Doing Business and ensuring Ease of Mining related services in J&K, Department of Geology and Mining has successfully implemented the recommended Business Reform Action Points circulated by Department for Promotion of Industries & Internal Trade (DPIIT), Government of India. Department of Geology & Mining has initiated creation of user-friendly environment by bringing its services through online mode only on <https://geologyminingjk.com> which is also integrated with J&K Single Window System at <https://singlewindow.jk.gov.in> to apply through a common platform under Business Reform Action Points and Minimizing regulatory compliance Burden (MRCB) with G2B/G2C interface.

For better transparency and proving user-friendly environment to the applicants, there shall not be any physical touch points between the applicant (Business/Citizens) and Department. Services are mandated through Jammu and Kashmir Public Service Guarantee Act, 2011 vide SRO-467, dated 16th October, 2018 for timely approval and MIS dashboard is made available in the Single Window System.


